## General Information Bowling Green Kentucky

**CHECK-OUT TIME - 12:00 NOON:** 11 AM for Kabins. Later check-out may be allowed when possible for a nominal fee. Please check availability at the office if you desire a late check-out on your departure date.

**VISITOR & KAMPER PASSES:** All vehicles must have a pass. Kampers will receive their passes upon registration. All visitors are asked to register at the office prior to going to a campsite. We do charge \$5.00 for those staying more than one hour. Please advise us of any expected visitors so that we will admit them to the park. We do limit the number of visitors per site. Visitors should not arrive before noon. Visitors must abide by the park rules and leave the park by 9:00 p.m. Overnight stays will be charged \$8.00 each. Registered kampers are responsible for their visitors.

**PARKING:** We limit the number of vehicles on each site to 2 including travel trailers. Parking is available for extra vehicles. All vehicles must have their passes. Visitors will be assigned parking areas. Advise your visitor in advance that they will be asked to use the designated parking area. Thank you for your cooperation. Anyone not using the passes will be asked to leave.

**QUIET TIME:** 9:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. No generators. No loud music or noises at any time. Youths must return to sites by 10:00 p.m.

**REFUNDS:** Cancellations in accordance with KOA policy with the following exceptions: 2 weeks notice for any holiday period, special event or reservations for multiple sites or reservations for more than 3 days. There is a \$5.00 processing fee on all cancellations. Camping is an outdoor experience and no refunds will be made for weather.

**SWIMMING POOL HOURS:** 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. if weather permits. Pool is seasonal and is open from the Friday before Memorial Day until after Labor Day. All children under 17 must be accompanied by an adult (state law). No cut-offs or street clothes allowed.

**PAY LAKE:** Pay Lake rules and hours are strictly enforced. Check with office for complete rules. No night fishing.

**FIRECRACKERS, FIREWORKS OR EXPLOSIVES** are not allowed in the park.

**FIREARMS:** Discharge of firearms not allowed on the premises.

**TRASH:** Please place all trash in plastic bags. Please help us keep the park clean. Since various little critters and birds often get into the garbage, we request that you place your trash bags in the dumpster by the Game Room. We do not pick up.

**NO DRAINING OF SINK (GREY) WATER:** State law does not permit draining of grey water on the ground.

**ONE KAMPING UNIT:** One camping unit per site. No more than 4 adults or 6 total including children.

**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** are permitted at your site only. Please keep visibility to a minimum. Not to be used in excess. Illegal drugs of any kind are not permitted in the park.

**KAMPFIRES** are allowed in fire rings only. No fires on grass. Please do not throw trash in fire rings.

**CUT TREES:** Please respect the trees. Do not cut, bend or drive nails into the trees. Anyone caught doing so will be fined \$25.00 or more depending on seriousness of the offense. No clotheslines.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** No mini-bikes or bicycles after dark.

**SPEED LIMIT:** In park speed limit of 10 M.P.H. will be enforced. Please drive carefully.

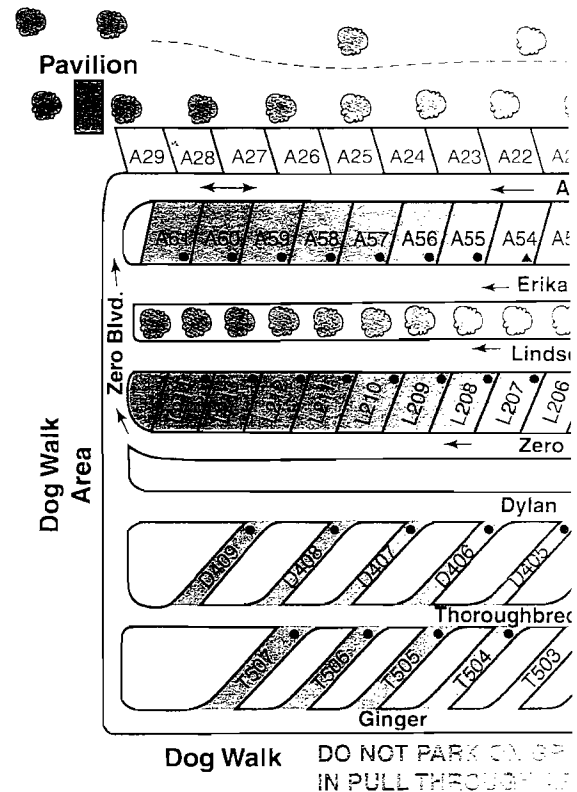
**PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS OF THEIR CHILDREN.** Remember, our lakes are deep.
